Brief History

- ~2000 - number of events
- SDF & CEWG initiate work on CoP
- Interim draft issued in 2003
- Issue 1 published in 2005
- That was the end of the beginning !!!

Current Status (2)

- Increasing involvement from stakeholders
 - The Winfrith Question
 - The Dounreay Shaft
 - Chapelcross Groundwater
- Increasing CEWG interaction with others to help ensure a common and consistent approach



Current Status (3)

However:

- Potential for ‘damage’ by lack of or misuse
- CEWG questions extent of awareness amongst project managers

- Revolve around wider application of the CoP
